Michael Walsh is the PMPO Boards point person for engagement with the DPLU. He administers and facilitates meetings and responses to the DPLU. He also chairs the 2020 Plan sub committee, and brings recommendation to the PMPO Board for review and approval.

The review of the DPLU newsletter is conducted on a monthly basis, and any additional correspondence from the DPLU is managed on demand

The reviews are conducted at various locations in Southern California, the Sub Committee meet to discuss these matters on Palomar Mountain on demand, the PMPO Board meet on Palomar Mountain on a quarterly basis

This activity is conducted to ensure that the PMPO are influencing the County Plans for the Palomar Mountain area

Approximately 60% of the PMPO Activity is focused on County Plan activities

The PMPO is a solely volunteer organization; any expenses incurred to enable these activities are drawn from the PMPO funds

The PMPO also serves the Palomar Mountain resident and land owners by monitoring and managing activities to promote the health of the mountain and it people;

- ground water monitoring,
